Staff has met with Channel Licensees/Grantees on the preparation of budget requests for Fiscal Year 2010-11, based on available PEG fee funds for capital facilities and equipment. All funding requests will be forwarded to staff, and then forwarded to the Board for consideration at their annual June budget hearing.

The Board concurred with staff's recommendation to cancel the April 1, 2010 Board meeting. The May 6, 2010 will be scheduled on an as needed basis, with the annual budget hearing scheduled for June 3, 2010.

For clarification purposes related to the audit of franchise fees remitted to SMCTC in Calendar Years 2007 & 2008, Tim Ray, AT&T, Inc.'s Executive Director of External Affairs stated it was through AT&T's own internal audit that determined shopping channels' franchise fees were not paid in Calendar Years 2007 & 2008. The outstanding amount was included in the franchise fee payment made in the first quarter of 2009. AT&T is researching why they have not received income from the Home Shopping Channel, as identified in Attachment I of the audit. Once a determination is made, the appropriate franchise fees will be remitted to SMCTC accordingly.

Philip Arndt, Comcast's Director of Franchising and Government Affairs in the Central Valley area introduced himself to the Board and presented information about Comcast's Digital Project in the Sacramento region.
